The Future for RSP International: Adapt or Die

The rules for survival of all species on this earth is adapt or die. So it is with manmade organizations like our RS Prussia International organization.

Our organization has remained relatively unchanged since its establishment in the 1980's. We do business much the same way we did 20 years ago, and even though our membership numbers have declined slowly, we still have basically the same members.

While we have enjoyed the benefits and pleasures of collecting Prussia and the fellowship of friends who also collect Prussia in the past 20 years, massive and significant changes have been occurring around us.

Some of those changes include: (1) We (early members) are now 20 years older and our lifestyle is starting to change. (2) New members will soon have to take over the responsibility of directing and leading the RSP International if it is to survive. (3) Economical and technical changes are having a major impact on our society and in the makeup and operation of RSP International in the future.
